How to Make **Chocolate Chip Cookies** by Crystal (Felicita)

I put **$\frac{3}{4}$ cup of brown sugar** into the bowl, **$\frac{3}{4}$ cup of white sugar** and **2 sticks of butter**. I creamed the sugar and butter. I added **2 large eggs**, **one teaspoon of vanilla** and **one teaspoon of salt**, **$2\frac{1}{4}$ cups flour**, and **1 teaspoon baking soda**. Put **1 bag of chocolate chips** in the bowl.

Stir it. Take a spoon put (the dough) it on the cookie sheet. Bake at **350 degrees** for **10 minutes**. Put the pan on top of the stove. (Then) eat the cookies!
